

Palatal Stent Instructions

- 1. Leave the stent in place for a full 24 hours following your procedure. If the stent is removed before this time period, you may have some swelling that occurs making it difficult to fit back in place.
- 2. After the initial 24 hours, you may remove the stent for cleaning purposes. Rinse both your moth and stent with water then put back into place.
- 3. Leave the stent in place while eating and drinking as not to disturb the surgical site.
- 4. We recommend that you wear the stent for the first 72 hours for comfort. After the third day you do not have to wear the stent unless you want to.
- 5. Removing the stent:
 - a. If you have one that has clasps, use your fingers to gently pull down on those.
 - b. If you have one without clasps, using a toothpick or something with a small point to it, gently push down between the stent and your teeth. This may seem difficult at first, but it will become easier with practice.
